Main Verse - (2 Corinthians 9:6-7)

MAIN THOUGHT

This passage encourages believers to be intentional and generous in their giving, emphasizing that the extent of one's generosity directly influences the abundance of blessings received.

PRACTICAL POINTS

Sow Generously for Abundant Harvest: The passage uses the analogy of sowing seeds to convey the principle that a generous giver will experience a bountiful return. Just as a farmer who sows generously reaps a plentiful harvest, those who give generously can expect abundance.

Heartfelt Giving, Not Reluctant or Compulsory: We see here the importance of giving willingly and cheerfully, not out of obligation or pressure. God values the attitude of the heart in giving, and cheerful generosity reflects a genuine desire to contribute to the well-being of others and the advancement of God's work.

God Loves a Cheerful Giver: God delights in those who give cheerfully. This implies that the attitude behind the giving is just as important as the act itself. Cheerful giving reflects a heart that understands and appreciates the grace and generosity of God.

PRACTICALITIES OF GIVING

- A. Before you come and bring your tithe/offering (pray and ask God what you should give).
- B. When you give. Thank Him for the ability. Thank Him for the finances to give. Do it with honor and worship in your heart.
- C. Give in faith with expectation.

CONCLUSION
